

Data Sheet School Farm Offices, Dunbridge, Hampshire





Reside Construction were instructed to construct a new purpose-built single-storey office adjacent to the fishing lodge in Dunbridge, Hampshire.

The new office building is set in a very much sought-after location, right next to the River Dun which boasts exclusive fishing rights.

The building is designed to complement the surrounding habitat, with natural local materials used such as Michelmersh roof tiles, oak cladding and Yorkstone paving surrounding the building with a covered walkway.

School Farm's office extension takes advantage of its location with fully glazed doors and windows from floor to ceiling on three sides of the building.

Underfloor heating and a woodburner provide the heating, with low energy lighting installed.

Works progressed well on site throughout the autumn and winter months of 2018, and we were delighted to hand over the structure to owners early in 2019.
