

Data Sheet Castle Street Surgery, Luton





Reside Construction Ltd was commissioned to assist in relocating a primary care centre to new premises over two floors in The Hatbox, Luton, Bedfordshire.

This involved extensive relocation of building services to the existing structure, complemented by the fit out of consulting rooms and a co-located pharmacy. Completion of the first floor formed the new premises for Castle Street Surgery, and the ground floor was utilised to form the pharmacy, general entrance and surgery amenity space.

Specific areas of note include the installation of secondary glazing throughout, and significant adaptation of the existing steel frame. Owing to the enclosed space, comprehensive ventilation systems were fitted, and a programme of external works carried out to include a car park and plant enclosure.

The site was handed over to the client in early November 2017.
