Naomi House Children's Hospice Completed September 2015



Naomi House children's hospice in Sutton Scotney, Hampshire, provides respite, emergency, end of life and bereavement care to life-limited children and their families in southern England. A £3.8m expansion and refurbishment contract was awarded to Reside Construction to re-establish Naomi House as a state of the art building.

The prestigious project comprises nearly 1,000m² of spacious new care environments and living areas, communal play spaces and accommodation for families, and a new extension known as the Hub. The Hub includes a spiritual centre with roof terrace and a cedar clad link bridge to connect Naomi House for the first time with Jackspace, the adjacent sister hospice for young people, allowing easier access to shared hydrotherapy facilities.

Extended bedrooms feature the latest clinical technology and the first UK installation of an efficient system enabling ambient control of room climate. Refurbished family accommodation provides a dedicated entrance foyer and lift access so that children receiving respite care can see where their parents and siblings are staying. A new suite of dedicated rooms provides much needed extra capacity for specialist emergency or end of life care.
