

Data Sheet Frith Park, Surrey





Reside Construction has joined forces with Reside Developments Ltd and Reigate's Urban Green Developments on a multi-million pound project to create a breathtaking collection of luxury mews cottages, villas and apartments set within the majestic Surrey Hills. The environmentally friendly project is located on ten acres of idyllic parkland, formal gardens and ancient woods, adjacent to the historic Headley Heath and iconic Box Hill.

Accessed via private gates and a sweeping tree-lined driveway, Frith Park comprises 26 new two & three bedroom cottages and four bedroom villas, together with 11 two and three bedroom apartments behind the restored original facade of the listed Mansion House.

Stable Mews, located within the original walled gardens, is home to the contemporary designed mews cottages. Redwood Terrace comprises 4 three bedroom cottages designed to resemble the original staff quarters, with full height floor to ceiling arched windows at the rear to overlook the landscaped gardens and Surrey countryside beyond.

A stunning collection of 12 three and four bedroom luxury villas are arranged in a courtyard setting, each with classic exteriors complementing the other properties across the development. Open plan family rooms form a highlight of the homes, with full width bifold sliding doors to the rear to open up the garden space. This first class residential development launches to market during Spring 2018.
